



## Transition to Work Program

**Inclusion NB** helps 10th-grade students with intellectual or developmental disabilities plan for life after high school, with a focus on employment or postsecondary education.

High school students will participate in various work readiness activities, including the following:

- Exploring different employment opportunities and gaining workplace experience through experiential learning opportunities.
- Learning about different employment opportunities and gaining workplace experience through experiential learning opportunities.
- Acquiring essential job-seeking skills, such as writing a resume and preparing for an interview.
- Participating in a work placement (co-op program) during their 12th grade.
- Exploring post-secondary education options as well as relevant support measures in place to achieve their goals.



## Just Enough Support

Inclusion NB's Transition Facilitators and students plan together using the ***Just Enough Support*** model. This recognizes the importance of seeking the right balance of natural supports, like friends and family, and accessing different types of technology and community-based services.

The purpose of this approach is to build bridges and help the student expand their social relationships and develop their personal autonomy and independence.
